3 Minutes of the previous meeting

3.1 Approval of the minutes

Previous minutes were circulated after the last meeting and no comments were received.

3.2 Matters arising from the minutes not covered by the agenda

There were no matters arising from the minutes that were not covered by existing agenda items.



4 Minutes

- 4.1 The agenda was presented as part of a slide deck that was used for the meeting (the slides can be found in the Meeting Papers folder of the Team site).
- 4.2 The Competition Law Compliance Policy reminder was presented.
- 4.3 The meeting proceeded with a discussion on actions from previous meetings, compliance policy and the status of existing action items. Some items are closed, and others are in progress. Members were encouraged to raise any compliance issues during the meeting.
- 4.4 Collaboration with the Marine Committee on emissions while on DP was discussed. An event is planned for later this year to bring energy companies and vessel operators together to discuss reducing fuel consumption and emissions. This is a work in progress, and updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
- 4.5 The Environmental Sustainability Committee is developing guidelines for CSRD (Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive). There was a discussion on learning from the Netherlands Shipowners Association and other organizations. Mark offered to keep the group updated on the progress of the Netherlands Shipowners Association's work on CSRD.
- 4.6 Discussion on the double materiality assessment and its implications for greenhouse gas reporting. Mark shared insights on the challenges of reporting and the need for a common approach to conversion factors and decarbonization roadmaps.
- 4.7 Nikos presented the structure and objectives of the Alternative Fuels Working Group. The focus is on consolidating knowledge on alternative fuels, vessel design, infrastructure, and regulatory updates. The group will hold hybrid meetings every three months and develop factual studies from members using alternative fuels.
- 4.8 The terms of reference for alternative fuels were discussed. Members are encouraged to join the work group to start as soon as possible. The focus will be on biofuels, blue fuels, and green fuels, as well as their impact on vessel design, infrastructure, and regulatory updates.
- 4.9 The discussion continued on the Alternative Fuels Working Group, with emphasis on mapping availability, understanding technical elements, and engaging with stakeholders across the value chain. The importance of biofuels and their short-term impact was highlighted.
- 4.10 The focus shifted to EU advocacy. A visit to Brussels was discussed, with plans for further meetings and events to educate about the offshore sector and influence regulations. The team met with various EU representatives and highlighted the need for better understanding of the offshore sector. Future visits and events are planned to continue this advocacy work.
- 4.11 Requests from BSM and Global Maritime to join the Greenhouse Gas Committee were discussed. Members are to provide feedback on these requests. The potential contributions of these organizations to the committee were considered, and it was suggested that they could participate in specific working groups, however this needs to decided by the members.
- 4.12 There was support for organizing a face-to-face meeting in the next 6-8 weeks. A poll will be sent out to determine the best date. The meeting will likely include discussions on the progress of the Alternative Fuels Working Group and other key topics.
